

## Fear of the Lord

- Genesis 20:11 - What exactly is that?
- Psalm 22:22-23 - "You who fear the Lord" is parallel to "All you descendants of Jacob" and "All you offspring of Israel"
- Psalm 85:8-9 - His salvation is near to those who fear Him.
- Psalm 115:11 - The Lord is a shield to those who fear Him; v.13 - He blesses those who fear Him.
- Luke 1:50 - His mercy is on those who fear Him.
  - What exactly does it mean to fear the Lord? This is not a one-dimensional, cut-and-dry answer. It is multi-faceted and has multiple layers. However, there is a large connection between fearing God and the Torah.

### What is the fear of the Lord?

(1) It causes one to have wisdom.

(6) In a positive sense, it causes one to obey out of love and reverence.  
In a negative sense, it causes one to fear and tremble because of looming judgement

- Exodus 1:17 ; 3:6 → Isaiah 6:5 ; 9:20-21, 30 ; 14:31 - "believed" - a man 589 - to have trust (faith)
- Leviticus 19:14, 32 → judgements are in chap. 20

- phobeo [
- Malachi 2:5 → morah 4172, yare, & chatat 2865 are all used
    - Torah of truth was in his mouth
    - Injustice (evel-5766 → unrighteousness, lawlessness) was not found on his lips
    - He walks in peace (shalom) & equity (mishor 4334 from yashar-righteousness)
    - He turns many away (shur) from sin (avon - 5771)
  - Acts 10:2, 22; 13:16, 26 - "Phoboumenoi ton Theon" or "Yare Hashamaim" - one who is not converted to Judaism, but keeps certain Jewish customs, such as the Sabbath and dietary laws.
  - Revelation 11:18; 19:5
