1. Sabbath is not to be kept. Keep Sunday instead.

Scripture references are: Genesis 2:1-3 rested (Strongs HW# 7673) means Shabbat or day of rest. 2. Passover is not to be kept. Observe Easter and take communion (transubstantiation) instead. 3. Pigs are to be eaten.

Leviticus 11:1-8 and vs. 44; Deuteronomy 14:8; Isaiah 65:2-6, 66:14-17; Matthew 8:30-32; 2 Corinthians 6:14-18; Mark 7:18-19; Acts 10:15 and vs. 28; Romans 14:14 (common not unclean);

4. Torah is not to be kept.

Catholic Church says it is not abolished but all of Scripture has been fulfilled.

Matthew 5:17-19 vs. 17 fulfilled (Strongs GW# 4137) Pleroo which means filled up, vs. 18 fulfilled (Strongs GW# 1096) Ginomai which means until everything in prophecy has come to pass

Pleroo (GW# 4137) is found in the following verses Matthew 3:15, 13:47-48, 23:31-32;

Luke 2:40 and 3:5; Acts 2:2 and vs. 28, 5:3 and verses 27-28, 7:23-25, 13:49-52; Romans 1:28-32, 15:19

5. Yeshua died on Good Friday and arose on Easter Sunday.

Matthew 12:39-41 and Matthew 16:4 (if He did die on Friday and rise on Sunday, then He is a false prophet.)

6. Make, carry and worship icons (graven images).

Exodus 20:4-5; Leviticus 26:1; Deuteronomy 4:15-17 and vs. 23, 7:25, 27:15

7. Mary is co-redemptrix.

Job 19:25; Psalm 19:14, 78:35; Isaiah 41:14, 43:14, 44:6, 47:4, 48:17, 54:5 and vs. 8

- 8. Yeshua was sinless because Mary was sinless her conception was the Immaculate Conception, not His. Isaiah 53:6 and Romans 3:23
- 9. Pope is Vicar of Christ incapable of error.

AntiChrist Vicar means in place of Christ

10. The church was built on Peter.

Matthew 16:17-18 Peter in Greek is Petros and is masculine. Rock is feminine (petra).
